Java's seat and back, which mirror each other, are soft and inviting despite the chair's rigorous design. The light and delicate metal frame gives this spacious chair a lovely sense of balance. It can be used in both private and public spaces, and because of the frame's detailing on the back and the integrated design of the back and seat, it's very suitable for placing anywhere in the room, either on its own or in a group.
