The result is a piece that feels both light and structural, an object that quietly transforms the space around it with its graceful presence.

Softly bending tradition into modernity, this family of chairs draws from the visual language of the Thonet world, reviving bentwood craftsmanship after 150 years. It carries a disciplined form, while the elegantly shaped armrests bring a delicate, feminine touch.

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The chair's defining feature is its elegantly rising back legs, which seamlessly merge into the backrest frame.

This design was born from a desire to reimagine traditional woodworking techniques, creating a piece that feels light and refined. Its low profile ensures that the backrest doesn't impose on its surroundings, allowing the chair to blend naturally into any space. What truly distinguishes this chair is the hand-bending technique applied to the back legs and armrest.

This craftsmanship, combined with the structural role of the backrest, eliminates the need for additional supports below the seat, creating a sense of lightness without compromising strength. The result is a chair that quietly enhances its environment while offering enduring sturdiness.

This interaction between components draws on a "dance-like" rhythm, where the soft, flowing lines of the front contrast with the steady, grounded support of the rear legs.

With its timeless appeal, it redefines the boundaries of universal design language, effortlessly blending in any space. Nikodem, a cabinet maker by heritage and an avid painter, recently revisited his best-selling Icho chair with a fresh perspective.

In refining Icho, he has balanced simplicity with intricate detailing, elevating the chair’s aesthetic without compromising its versatility or function.

The chair features specially placed bead-pearls on its backrest, introducing a dynamic element that offers both distraction and meditation.

Crafted from wood, the chair's natural grain is visible even on the beads in the fully stained version, adding to its charm.

Movable beads engage the user's hands, providing a tactile experience whether in conversation or while waiting calmly. By incorporating these interactive elements, the furniture fosters a multi-dimensional dialogue with its user. To balance the chair's substantial form, a woven mat is used for the seat and back. This choice not only lightens the chair visually but also enhances its overall sense of grace and delicacy.

Its construction is defined by turned wooden legs that sometimes act as seat supports and, at other times, extend upward to form sleek armrests. An optional upholstery accessory adds a layer of softness to the design, enhancing comfort without compromising its elegance.
